

transportation to the event site throughout the day. The event is sponsored by San Onofre Parks Foundation. www.SanOParks.org





SPRING (VERNAL) EQUINOX, 8:50 PM, MARCH 19TH: On the equinoxes, the Sun shines directly on the equator and the length of day and night is nearly equal — but not quite. The March equinox marks the moment the Sun crosses the celestial equator — the imaginary line in the sky above the Earth's equator. Happy first day of fall to friends in the southern hemisphere.

GRUNION SEASON: March begins the season when grunion arrive on our beaches to spawn. They come in at night beginning at high tide, usually 2 days after the full moon and the new (no) moon over a 2-hour period for 3 or 4 nights in a row. They're expected on March, 11 (11:37 PM), 12 (12:18 AM), 13 (1:03 AM), 14 (2:00 AM) & 26 (11:08 PM), 27 (11:31 PM), 28 (11:57 PM) & 29 (12:30 AM) (grunion do not read prediction charts, no guarantees). March is an open month (allowed to take them), April and May are closed months (looking only) and June through August are open. Grunion

catchers 16 years and over must have a CA fishing license. You must use your hands only, no nets or holes in the sand. Take only what you will use. It is unlawful and unethical to waste fish.
